There are 6 different activities that have been created to aid you in your prayers and we would encourage you to share with others what you learn as you pray into these different themes and listen to the voice of God. There are also ways to be creative and we would encourage you to share pictures of your creativity with your friends and on social media. Let's let the world know that we as a faith family are praying for them.

We also recognise that these are unsettling times and some of you may be unwell, afraid, anxious or struggling to cope with the lockdown.

There is not a specific activity designed for our current Corona-virus situation but we trust that the issues of anxiety, ill health, our government and their wisdom in decision making, individuals we know of that need God's intervention at this current time, and our own needs will run through the whole 24 hours of prayer.

As we journey with Christ over the next few days we have the advantage of knowing the whole story. We know that he is as real today as he was then, that he calls us into relationship with him now as he did the disciples then, and that he reigns in power and will come again! Hallelujah!
